COVID-19 DAILY BRIEFING

- All PPE, except procedure masks, should be removed before entering public spaces, *including the cafeteria*.
- PPE should only be worn in appropriate clinical spaces or when performing clinical tasks, such as patient transport.
- This includes face shields, booties, gloves, gowns, and disposable bouffant caps.
- Only procedure masks, which are required in all areas of the hospital, should be worn in public spaces.
- All PPE, should be disposed of before leaving the hospital. It is inappropriate to dispose of any PPE, <u>including procedure</u> <u>masks</u>, outside on the grounds or in the parking garage.

COVID-19 Staff with Suspected COVID-19

- Instead, those staff should be directed to contact their PCP. For staff without a PCP, the UH Emergency Department and Ambulatory Medicine Clinic are open to the public and available to staff as well.
- Before visiting the Ambulatory Medicine Clinic, staff should first call the ACC Triage Nurse Line at (973)714-0005.
- Staff with confirmed or suspected COVID-19, should still call Employee Health at x2-3066 to report their symptoms.
