The U.S. Air Force Air Demonstration Squadron, the Thunderbirds, and the U.S. Navy Flight Demonstration Squadron, the Blue Angels, will fly a formation of 6 F-16 C/D Fighting Falcon and 6 F-18C/D Hornet aircraft as a collaborative salute from the Air Force and Navy to recognize healthcare workers, first responders, military, and other essential personnel while standing in solidarity with all Americans during the COVID-19 pandemic.

This jet formation is expected to reach the skies over Newark at approximately a few minutes after noon time today.
