Vacation Time, and Hero Pay Updates

During the surge in coronavirus cases, University Hospital was forced to limit time-off requests to two days and cancel scheduled vacations. As part of our phased return to normal operations, important changes have been announced.

- The previous restrictions on using vacation and float holiday time have ended. Vacation requests which had been approved for July 1st and later will be honored without the employee having to take any further action. Should a staff member wish to cancel such an approved time off request, they should do so before June 12th.
- Due to the decline in Covid-19 cases, the "Heroes Fund Bonus Pay" and "Crisis Extra Shift Incentive" programs have also concluded.

COVID-19 Elective Surgeries Resuming

- Effective May 26th, we have resumed Elective Procedures. These surgeries will only be allowed pursuant to strict guidelines provided by the Department of Health.
- University Hospital is prepared to resume Elective Procedures immediately, and will continue to review our policies and
