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#### Mandatory Masking Policy

University Hospital has adjusted its policy regarding the wearing of procedure masks. The new policy mandates that all personnel at the hospital wear procedure masks while in clinical areas and, when possible, in non-clinical areas as well. This does not change the existing protocol for use of PPE, including N95 masks, while providing patient care. Additional details are included in the full policy document.

#### **Child Care Assistance**

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### **Disposal of PPE Reminder**

Staff are reminded that proper doffing procedures for PPE includes disposal instructions. Depending on its use, PPE should be disposed of as medical or solid waste in appropriate receptacles.

The hospital has received reports of PPE discarded on the ground in hospital parking facilities. For the safety of our patients and staff, and for the professional workplace that we all take pride in maintaining, PPE must be discarded in appropriate receptacles.

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### **Important Reminders**

Travel Restrictions: All UH staff are part of an essential service, and are not impacted by the recent travel restrictions from the CDC, Governor Murphy, or Mayor Baraka, for purposes of commuting to work at the hospital. In order to avoid issues, it is recommended that staff carry their IDs with them at all times.

**Dress Code:** University Hospital is relaxing its official dress code to enable all employees to come to work in clothing that can be washed at home, and to avoid clothing that requires dry-cleaning. All staff are encouraged to dress in business casual clothing that is neat and appropriate to the workplace.
