Updated DoH Travel Advisory - Four States Added to the Quarantine List



Improving Health Through Leadership and Innovation

Governor Murphy this week advised individuals traveling to New Jersey from additional states with significant community spread of COVID-19 to quarantine for a 14-day period from the time of last contact within the identified state. The updated advisory includes four additional states - Minnesota, New Mexico, Ohio, and Wisconsin - with Delaware removed from the list. The travel advisory applies to any person arriving from a state with a positive test rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents or a state with a 10 percent or higher positivity rate over a 7-day rolling average. University Hospital recommends that you avoid traveling to the states identified in the Travel Advisory. If you choose to travel to these locations, you should discuss your plans with your manager and continue to follow infection control protocols, including monitoring your temperature and wearing a mask. Managers continue to have discretion to deny this use of leave as business needs dictate.

confirmed COVID-19 patients currently. Dr. Elnahal pointed out that our procurement staff have been working hard during this period to source supplies and that UH currently has more than 60 days worth of PPE in stock.
