## **Interventional Radiology Pre-Procedure Requirements**

- 1. All patients are required to not eat or drink (NPO) after midnight prior to procedure
- 2. All patients with a history of seafood/shellfish allergies need to be premedicated with a prednisone prep prior to procedure
- 3. Patients with renal disease may require a mucomyst protocol (Acetylcystine)
- 4. Patients taking Aspirin daily must stop for 5-7 days before procedure (patients on other NSAIDs, such as Motrin, Advil, Motrin IB, Naprosyn, and Aleve must stop at least 3 days before procedure).
  - \*Please contact your Cardiologist before stopping Aspirin therapy.
- 5. Patients on anticoagulants must stop medication according to the instructions below:
  - Coumadin- at least 3 days before procedure
  - Lovenox- at least 1 day before procedure

## \*Please contact your Primary Care Physician before stopping anticoagulants

- 6. Patients with low platelets or high INR will need to be transfused with the appropriate blood products before procedure.
  - Platelet count must be > 50,000
  - INR must be < 1.5
- 7. All labwork to include CBC, BMP, PT/INR must be available and less than 30 days old.

Patients will be asked to report to Same Day Surgery or the Angiography suite on the day of procedure.
